- If you wish to have an absentee ballot mailed to you, the last mailing, by law, is Saturday, November 4 by 2:00 p.m. The office will be open this day from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for the purpose of issuing Absentee Ballots.
- ***Please don't postpone. Apply early to be sure your ballot arrives on time.***
- The last day to pick up an Absentee Ballot in person is November 6, and it must be voted in person at the township hall.
