Please don't postpone. Apply early to be sure your ballot arrives on time. The last day to pick up an Absentee Ballot in person is Monday, August 6, 2018 from 9 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and it must be voted in person at the township hall on that date.

The polling place is located at the Webster Township Hall, 5665 Webster Church Road, and is handicapped accessible with voting available in alternate forms (audio and braille).
