## **ELECTION INFORMATION**

**Dear Webster voters:**

For the upcoming **November 3, 2020 election**, we are preparing to make voting as safe as possible for ALL. One of our utmost goals is to protect our dedicated election inspectors that have chosen to serve Webster Township, even in these challenging times with Covid-19.

**MASKS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED ON ELECTION DAY and SOCIAL DISTANCING IS REQUIRED.**

**For in-person voting, please note:**

- MASKS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED for the safety of our workers and voters.
- 6-foot social distancing is required and will put voters outside as they wait to enter the building.
- Sanitizing of surfaces and equipment will be done throughout the day.

**For Absentee Ballot voting, please note:**

- **ALL** Michigan voters are now eligible to apply for an Absentee Ballot.
- **We will not SEND A BALLOT until we RECEIVE YOUR APPLICATION, and confirm your signature.** Applications can be obtained at the township hall or online at [mi.gov/vote](https://mi.gov/vote)
- The last day to request a ballot be MAILED to you is Friday, October 30, 2020.
- You can still obtain an Absentee Ballot IN PERSON at the Webster Township Hall during office hours, through Monday, November 2 and also on Saturday, October 31 from 9-5. Please note that our Monday-Thursday 8-4 hours could fluctuate with Covid restrictions so check our website or call before you come.
- Go to [mi.gov/vote](https://mi.gov/vote) to track your Application and Ballot
- **Absentee Ballots need to be AT THE TOWNSHIP by 8 pm on November 3 to be counted.**
- Use our new DRIVE-UP 24-hour drop box instead of mail to ensure your ballot arrives on time!
